

Smithtown Stitchers Block of the Month 2018

Bring to the October Meeting
Block 5 Lucy Hayes Double T Block

Use 4 colors plus background fabric. Directions yield (2) 12 ½" blocks

Go Cutter

Corner Half Square Triangles (large HST)

Cut: (8) 5¼" squares – 1 of each color and 4 of the background

Using die #3 from the 8" cube, or die #55710, cut the fabric- yields (8) HST

Arrow units (small HST)

Cut: (16) 3" x 7½" rectangles: 2 of each color and 8 of background fabric. Lay background fabric on top of color fabric, right sides together and fold in half to measure 3 x 3¾". Using die #55018 cut fabric – yields (32) HST

Center

Cut (2) 5" squares using either focus fabric or background fabric. Use large square on 'small value die' that came with your go-cutter, and cut (2) 4 ½" squares. Assemble as shown being careful of color placement.

Rotary Cutter

Corner Half Square Triangles (large HST)

Cut (1) 5 ¼" square from each color and (4) 5 ¼" squares of background.

Mark diagonal on each background fabric. Sew ¼" on either side of marked line and cut apart. Square up to 4 ½". Yields 8 HST

Arrow units (small HST)

Cut (4) 3 ½" squares from each color and (16) 3 ½" squares from background.

Mark diagonal line on background fabric. Sew ¼" on each side – Cut apart and square up to 2 ½". Yields 32 HST

Center

Cut (2) 4 ½" squares of either background fabric or focus fabric

Assemble as shown: Be careful of color placement.

Note: Small HST match with large corner HST
