Block of the Month #6 due November 2018

Directions using the AccuQuilt Go Cutter

From background cut: 4 @ 4" ea. Cut on die #2 from 12" cube

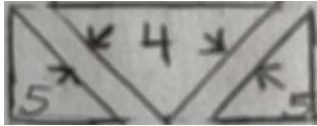
From background cut: 2 @ 7 3/4" sq. Cut on die #4 from 12" cube. Yields 8 large inner triangles for flying geese

From dark cut: 8 @ 4" x 4 3/4" Cut on die #5 from 12" cube. Yields 16 smaller outer triangles for flying geese

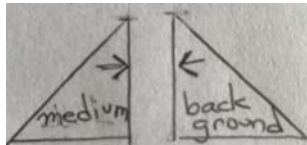
From background cut 4 @ 4" x 4 3/4" Cut on die #5 from 12" cube. Yields 8 outer triangles for pinwheel unit

From background cut 4 @ 3 3/4" x 3" Place background on top of medium.
From medium cut 4 @ 3 3/4" x 3" Cut (8) 2 1/2" half square triangles using #55018 (value die). Yields 8 pair of pinwheel units

1- Sew a dark triangle from die #5 to both legs of triangle from die #4 Yields 8 flying geese units that measure 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" each



2- Sew half square triangles together @ legs placing the background to medium. Yields 8 pinwheel units



3- Sew this pinwheel unit to the background triangle unit from die #5. Yields 8 pinwheel units



4- Sew according to diagram
