
2021 Guild Raffle Quilt SCRAPPY WONKY STARS

Please use medium/bright colors for the stars and white, cream and/or tone on tone for the pale background. You can make either a 6" block(s) or a 9" block



Cutting Chart:

1. Take one of your background squares and place a rectangular scrap over it (right sides together) as shown in the image below. Sew a seam 1/4" from the edge of the scrap. Then, trim the excess seam and press open. Trim again so that the unit is square again.

2. Using the square you just made, take another strip and lay it over the other side of the unit, right sides together, as shown below. Again, sew a seam 1/4" from the edge of the scrap. Trim the seam, press open and then square it up again. Repeat steps 1 and 2 until you have made four units.



BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

If you make all the star's legs at all different angles and different sizes, it creates a "wonkier" star. No two blocks should be the same.

- 1. Use medium/bright scrap fabrics to make the 4 "star" parts and the center square.
- 2. Use white, cream or tone on tone fabrics for the background. You can even use different creams and whites in each square.
- DO NOT extend any of the star legs to the corner of the background fabric as the points might get cut off when assembling the block.
- 4. Sew the squares together as you would a 9 patch per the diagram pictured above.

NOTE: All seams are 1/4" with the block measuring 1/2" larger than the finished size your are making. So 6" blocks measure 6.5", 9" blocks, 9.5".
